Coastal Regional Sediment Management Plan Study Area

Plan :	National Park Service – Golden Gate National Recreation area and Muir Woods National Monument Draft General Management Plan
Description:	This plan is intended to guide management of the park over the next 20 years. Prepared over the last five years, the draft plan contains various ideas for future management of the park. Some of these came from the public and park partners, and others build upon earlier successes or from lessons learned by day-to-day management of the park since 1972 as directed by the 1980 General Management Plan.
Geographic Area:	Muir Woods and Golden Gate National Recreation Area, including parklands and beaches along the San Francisco and San Mateo County coastlines.

Plan :	Ocean Beach Master Plan
Description:	Working in cooperation with a host of federal, state and local agencies; community stakeholders; and the public, San Francisco Planning + Urban Research (SPUR) has developed a landmark climate adaptation and open space plan to address the many issues at Ocean Beach. The plan recommends six key moves that chart an ambitious and proactive vision for managing a changing coastline, protecting critical sewer infrastructure and significantly upgrading public access to the beach.

Plan :	City of Daly City General Plan/Local Coastal Program Update
Description:	The City of Daly City is undertaking a comprehensive update of its General Plan and Local Coastal Program (LCP). The last such update occurred more than 20 years ago. An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is now being prepared for the Draft General Plan/LCP. The City expects that the EIR will be completed in the fall of 2012, with General Plan/LCP adoption occurring shortly thereafter. These documents will guide land use planning and development decision-making within the City for the next 20 years.

Plan :	City of Pacifica General Plan/Local Coastal Program Update
Description:	The City of Pacifica is comprehensively updating its General Plan and Local Coastal Program (LCP) for the first time since 1980. The City has prepared a draft of the plan and determined that an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) will be necessary. The EIR is expected to be completed in winter or spring of 2013. Once completed, the plan will provide a vision and policies for land use, economic development, environmental protection, and infrastructure investment through 2030.
